The 150th issue of *Media International Australia* will be published in February 2014. To mark this auspicious occasion, *MIA* will feature a special 150th issue, to be co-edited by Sue Turnbull, Bridget Griffen-Foley and Gerard Goggin.

This issue will contain three sections. The first will deal with the history of *MIA*, and the second with new scholarship emerging from contributions to *A Companion to Australian Media* (edited by Bridget Griffen-Foley, to be published in mid-2014).

A third section has been allocated to the inclusion of new perspectives and emergent voices in the field of media and communications, and we invite scholars who are engaged in ground-breaking research in any relevant field to submit a contribution to this landmark issue of *MIA*.

We are asking for contributions of 3000 words that address new developments in the field of media and communication research.

Established scholars who are themselves engaged in new fields of research are also warmly invited to submit a proposal.
